Course Description: Stage Makeup will be an elementary introduction to the use of stage makeup supplies and correct hygiene procedures for facial skin care. Each class will start with a lecture and demonstration of the daily makeup application or hygiene routine. Then time will be allotted for the students to experiment with the same exercise. The end of class will be reserved for makeup removal, organizing and sanitizing supplies, and general clean up.

Materials: The \$45 participation fee will provide necessary materials for the students to complete the course including personal makeup kits, shared special effect supplies, applicators, cleaning solvents, and lecture materials. Skin pigment matching will be required to get the appropriate supplies. Some mirrors will be provided, but if students have access to additional mirrors or vanity lights, they are encouraged to bring them. Students may be required to share mirror and light space due to limited supply.

Allergy Caution: This course uses primarily Ben Nye products. Descriptions of those products can be found online, but a brief inclusion of some materials are:

- Cream based foundations - including beeswax mixtures
- Liquid Latex
- Scar Wax
- Fake blood
- Crepe Hair
- Spirit Gum
- Spirit Gum Remover - acetone or isopropyl alcohol may substitute
- Foam applicators
- Brush applicators
- Plastic applicators
